

### Scholarship Award Processing Timeline

Date	Action
<b>Late June – September</b>	Students attend Summer term classes.
<b>1-Jul</b>	First day that Summer term scholarship and financial aid funds can be disbursed to student accounts.
<b>Early August</b>	OSU application for fall term admission becomes available.
<b>Late August</b>	All requests for Summer term departmental scholarship awards for students graduating in Summer term must be submitted no later than two weeks before the term ends.
<b>1-Oct</b>	The electronic Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the Oregon Student Aid Application (ORSAA) for the next academic year become available for students and families to complete at <a href="http://fafsa.ed.gov">fafsa.ed.gov</a> and <a href="https://oregonstudentaid.gov/fafsa-orsaa.aspx">https://oregonstudentaid.gov/fafsa-orsaa.aspx</a> .
<b>November – September</b>	Automatic University Scholars Program (USP) scholarships (e.g., Finley, Provost, etc.) are awarded to prospective students by the Scholarship Office based on their application for admission.
<b>1-Feb</b>	Priority deadline for prospective freshmen students to submit an application for admission in order to be considered for USP scholarships. Students who apply after February 1 will be considered on a funds-available basis.
<b>Early February</b>	New student housing application available
<b>March – June</b>	Competitive USP scholarships (e.g., Presidential, Diversity, etc.) are awarded to prospective students.
<b>March – September</b>	Departmental scholarships are awarded to prospective and continuing students for the next academic year.
<b>Mid-March</b>	Notification of financial aid awards for the next academic year begins for prospective and continuing students.

### Scholarship Award Processing Timeline

Date	Action
<b>15-Mar</b>	Priority deadline for prospective transfer students to submit an application for admission in order to be considered for USP scholarships. Students who apply after March 15 will be considered on a funds-available basis.
<b>1-May</b>	Deadline for prospective students to accept USP scholarship awards and financial aid awards through MyOregonState.
<b>Early May</b>	Registration for START sessions begins.
<b>June – September</b>	Incoming students participate in START sessions.
<b>June – September</b>	Residence hall room assignments made for incoming students.
<b>Mid-September</b>	Fall term scholarship and financial aid funds are disbursed to student accounts beginning 10 days prior to the beginning of the term.
<b>September – December</b>	Students attend Fall term classes.
<b>Late September</b>	Fall census. Credit hours for the term are locked after the add/drop deadline. Financial aid is adjusted to reflect the students' official credit enrollment for the term. Students must be enrolled in at least 12 credits to be eligible for USP scholarships.
<b>Early November</b>	Registration holds for outstanding unpaid bills are placed on students' accounts.
<b>Late November</b>	All requests for Fall term departmental scholarship awards for students graduating in Fall term must be submitted no later than two weeks before the term ends.
<b>Late December</b>	All students with USP scholarships are evaluated for progress towards their specific renewal GPA and credit requirements. Status notifications are sent to all students via email.

### Scholarship Award Processing Timeline

Date	Action
<b>Late December</b>	Winter term scholarship and financial aid funds are disbursed to student accounts beginning 10 days prior to the beginning of the term.
<b>January – March</b>	Students attend Winter term classes.
<b>Mid-January</b>	Winter census. Credit hours for the term are locked after the add/drop deadline. Financial aid is adjusted to reflect the students' official credit enrollment for the term. Students must be enrolled in at least 12 credits to be eligible for USP scholarships.
<b>Late January</b>	Students with a USP scholarship are reviewed to evaluate whether they are on track to complete the number of credits and earn the GPA required for automatic renewal. If it appears that the eligibility requirements will be met, the USP scholarship is loaded for the next academic year. If it appears that the eligibility requirements will not be met, an estimated USP scholarship is not loaded for the next academic year.
<b>Mid-February</b>	Registration holds for outstanding unpaid bills are placed on students' accounts.
<b>Early March</b>	All requests for Winter term departmental scholarship awards for students graduating in Winter term must be submitted no later than two weeks before the term ends.
<b>Late March</b>	All students with USP scholarships are evaluated for progress towards their specific renewal GPA and credit requirements. Status notifications are sent to all students via email.
<b>Late March</b>	Spring term scholarship and financial aid funds are disbursed to student accounts beginning 10 days prior to the beginning of the term.
<b>April – June</b>	Students attend Spring term classes.

### Scholarship Award Processing Timeline

Date	Action
<b>Early April</b>	Spring census. Credit hours for the term are locked after the add/drop deadline. Financial aid is adjusted to reflect the students' official credit enrollment for the term. Students must be enrolled in at least 12 credits to be eligible for USP scholarships.
<b>Early May</b>	The Scholarship Office notifies campus scholarship administrators of the deadline to submit requests for departmental scholarship payments for the academic year.
<b>Mid-May</b>	Registration holds for outstanding unpaid bills are placed on students' accounts.
<b>31-May</b>	Deadline to submit all requests for Spring term and academic year departmental scholarship awards.
<b>Late June</b>	After Spring term grades have been submitted, each student with a USP scholarship is reviewed to verify whether they have completed the number of credits and earned the GPA required for automatic renewal. If the eligibility requirements are met, the USP scholarship is automatically renewed for the next academic year. If the eligibility requirements are not met, the USP scholarship is cancelled for the next academic year.
<b>30-Jun</b>	Fiscal year ends. Scholarship payments for the prior academic year can no longer be processed.
<b>Last Friday in September</b>	Deadline for students to submit an appeal to the Scholarship Office requesting reinstatement of USP scholarship awards that were cancelled due to GPA and/or credit completion.
